**Directions to Que Sera Farms:**

-Take 46 W towards Nashville. Once you have passed under I65 turn Left at the top of the hill on to Goeller Blvd. Then Left on to Terrace Lake Road. When Terrace Lake T's turn Left on to 200S. Then turn Right on to Crossing Lane which becomes 300S. Stay on 300S til it T's at Grandview Lake Dam(will go through 2 stop signs). Turn Left at Grandview Lake Dam on to 650W. Then take first Right on to Bellesville Pike The Farm is about 3 ½ miles down Bellesville Pike. Different GPS's will give different ways to go but we have found this to be the easiest route.

There will be some green neon signs to help with directions.
